Our first month of kindergarten is over and we can tell we are going to have a great year!! During the month of September we learned how to come to school, follow classroom rules and how to be responsible for the things in the classroom. We also reviewed shapes, colors and read many books! We have been working with the numbers 1 - 10 and letters in the alphabet.

Our topics of study this month will be Five Senses and the Four Seasons. We will be making two different books in class and the students will bring them home to share with you at the end of each unit.
